What things do I care to be involved in?

What things do I not want to be involved in?

CHALLENGES

What behaviors might lead me to feel disconnected from my build team?

What behaviors cause me frustration with coworkers? With my friends?

What things might cause a breakdown in the relationship?

NARROW YOUR OPTIONS

WEBSITE & SOCIAL MEDIA

Is the informational helpful & relevant? What's their personality like?

REVIEWS & TESTIMONIALS

What are others saying about their experience with the builder?

PORTFOLIO

Do they have a board portfolio? Do they build in your style?

PREPARE FOR THE INITIAL CONSULTATION

LIST YOUR MUST-HAVES

What are the most important things you must have in your custom build? (Think about everything from exterior to layout to finishes).

BRING INSPIRATTION

What photos on social media do you have to share?

What do you want your home to look like?

What do you want your home to feel like?

What's your style(s)?

PREPARE QUESTIONS

What do you want to make sure you find out from the builder?

What do you need more information about?

COMMON RED FLAGS

PRICE TOO LOW

- How does this builder's price compare to the others?
- Is the price unrealistic or too good to be true?
- Have some details been left out of the price?

TIMELINE TOO SHORT

- How does this builder's timeline compare to the others?
- Are they outlining every aspect of the build in the project?
- Is their schedule detailed and organized?

NOT TAILORED TO YOU

- Did they ask enough questions and listen to your requirements?
- Is the proposal tailored to your requirements?
- Is the documentation specific to your project or is it generic?
